**REHABCARE GENERAL COUNSEL ANNOUNCES RESIGNATION**

**ST. LOUIS, MO, March 27, 2007**—RehabCare Group, Inc. (NYSE: RHB) has announced that David B. Groce, Senior Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary, will step down from his position and voluntarily resign from the company effective June 1 to move to Montana and pursue personal investment and new business opportunities.

In making the announcement, John H. Short, Ph.D. RehabCare President and CEO, said, "We created the Office of the General Counsel with David's appointment in December 2005. In a relatively short period of time, he has refined and elevated a role that has had a pronounced influence on every aspect of our business."

Dr. Short added that, under Groce's brief leadership, RehabCare achieved closure on several significant legal issues. "David's experienced counsel has been an invaluable resource in an oftentimes complicated business environment," commented Dr. Short. "We will be sorry to see him go, but wish him success in future endeavors."

The company is beginning its search for a successor.
